Randy Blasch and John Keown Receive PM Aprons

At the communication of January 25, Past Masters Randy Blasch and John Keown were presented



with Past-Master's Aprons. The aprons had been ordered from the Luther catalog just the week before, and they arrived in time to be presented at our regular dinner meeting. Shown at left are WB Keown and WB Ben Johnson, as the new apron is being displayed. It is customary for outgoing worshipful masters to receive an apron, presented to them by the Lodge, but recently that custom has been neglected. It is hoped that in the future the presentation will be made at the annual communication of SS Lodge held on the second Tuesday of the month of December. John was Master of the Lodge for the year 2004.
